Clarifying information from ITTF:

This is a modified version of the ITU-T, ISO, IEC common text patent form for interim use by

JTC 1.

ISO, IEC and ITU-T through WSC have set up a task force to look at harmonizing the patent policies and part of this activity should also result in a common patent declaration form which should be approved by the relevant bodies in ISO and IEC in the first or second quarter of 2006.

At that moment in time, JTC 1 should use that approved form instead of this one.

It needs to be understood however that the form is not fully consistent with the ISO/IEC patent policy, but is a convenient way of collecting information, and the concept of reciprocity needs to be adequately defined. For the latter, the ITU definition given in the form will suffice. On the former, we do not recognize the separate status of royalty free or reciprocity and consider them simply to be instances of RAND. Anyone checking such boxes will therefore be considered to be

compyling with the ISO/IEC RAND policy.
