And would be happy to participate and contribute on the harmonization, because of the following reasons: In the field of mobile applications, in which technology and its application to services are making rapid advances, integrated services, for example, IC card services with mobile micro-payment functions should be provided without affecting convenience of end users. It is important for those industries to obtain both collateralized compatibility between 14443 and 18092. And it is also important for those industries to preserve its each backward compatibility. JNB/SC6 would like to take a role of the Convener as SC6 side.

Liaison Statement **from ISO/IEC JTC1/SC17 to ISO/IEC JTC1/SC6**

Title:

Harmonization activities for the standards ISO/IEC 18092, 21481, 22536, 23917 and ISO/IEC 14443, 10373-6

The standards ISO/IEC 18092, 21481, 22536, 23917 (NFC standards) and ISO/IEC 14443, 10373-6 (14443) have had much in common in the year 2003, when the developers of the NFC standards had been technically very close to 14443 definitions. 14443, however, has been developed further since its publication in the year 2001, aiming at improving it for increasing interoperability. The results of the past years' intensive development within SC17 are reflected by the new texts of 14443, those of which are the currently processed parts 1 and 4 as FDIS, the parts 2 and 3 as 2nd CDs and 10373-6 as WD, the latter expected to be launched as a CD by April 2008.

SC17 sees it advantageous for both SC6 and SC17 in terms of an increase of market potential, if an active Liaison co-operation of both SCs took place. Such a Liaison co-operation would also avoid duplication in the development and maintenance of standards, which would minimize resources and would concentrate expertise.

Considering the above facts, SC17 asks SC6 to organize and hold an:

SC6-SC17 Liaison Meeting on NFC and 14443

on the 1st and 2nd of April 2008 in Tokyo, Japan. Such meeting would be chaired by two Conveners, one of whom nominated by SC6 and the other one nominated by SC17.

SC17 expects that meeting to follow the following proposed Terms of Reference:

- Presentation of the current status of ISO/IEC 18092, 21481, 22536, 23917 (NFC) and ISO/IEC 14443, 10373-6 (14443)
- Comparison of NFC and 14443
 - Where are equal technical definitions,
 - where very similar ones,
 - where different ones,
 - where missing and needed ones?
- Analysis of NB's requests where and why to bridge NFC and 14443
- Investigation of a work method and work plan, to be commonly agreed by SC6 and SC17, for harmonizing NFC and 14443
- Drafting a proposal for a related SC6-SC17 Liaison Project to be submitted to SC6 and SC17 for approval
